



<u>Do not</u> submit multiple submissions within the same email. Please separate them as this will help us keep track of each submission.

<u>Do</u> include all content in the email. If content is too much for a single email, then please make sure to reference that there are multiple emails related to your submission (Example: You can add "Email 1 of 3" in the subject line)

The Email's subject should include:

"Club Name" <u>or</u> "Committee Name" **and** "DG Newsletter" **and/or** "Lions Magazine" submission. **Club submission**

<u>Sample Subject</u>: "Ajax Lions Club – DG Newsletter and Lions Magazine Submission"

Committee submission

Sample Subject: "Webmaster/IT - DG Newsletter Submission"
