#### **Committee submission**

On Tuesday, March 31, 2020, the Newmarket Lions Club delivered 1,900 bottles of water, 800 juice boxes, 1,600 potato chip bags, 1,600 granola bars, 800 individually wrapped cookies, 10,000 chocolate bars, and assorted chocolate and candy bars, 600 Chapstick, and 800 Kleenex packages, to the nurses, doctors and staff at Southlake Regional Hospital. The club answered a request made by the Southlake Hospital Foundation to help relieve some of the stress brought on by the pandemic emergency.

"The community needs to come together and provide some assistance for these people who are not only stressed with helping the sick but also stressing over their own health and the health of their families," said Sylvia Brock, President of the Newmarket Lions Club. The total donation was valued at \$3,500.00.


#### In Support of our District Governor Elect
